President Raymond Byrne, Jr. called the May meeting of the McKenzie Fire & Rescue Board of Directors to order at 12:04 p.m. on Monday, May 16, 2022, at the Leaburg Training Center, 42870 McKenzie Highway, Leaburg, Oregon.

<u>Approval of Budget Meeting Minutes</u>: Rick Thompson moved to accept the Budget meeting minutes, as presented, of the April 18, 2022, Budget committee meeting. Lee Means seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

<u>Approval of Board Meeting Minutes</u>: Lee Means moved to accept the minutes, as presented, of the April 18, 2022, Board meeting. Derek Wing seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: A motion to file the treasurer's report for the month of April, subject to audit, was made by Rick Thompson. Derek Wing seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Chief's Report: Chief Bucich's written report was included in the Board packet. Also discussed:

Logistics Building: We received one bid for the Disaster Relief Logistics Building from Ausland Group. We met with them to discuss preliminary items: budget, location, square footage, wants and needs.

Water Tank: The District was finally granted permits for the Weyerhaeuser/Deerhorn Road water tank. Lane County Planning required a General Contractor (GC) for this project, which has not happened in the past. NATCO Development agreed to be the GC for this project. We will be meeting with the Weyerhaeuser representative this afternoon to review site work.

WUI Grant: The new Type VI chassis was picked up on Monday, May 2nd and delivered shortly thereafter to Cascade Fire in Medford. It will remain there until the box is installed.



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Seasonal Staffing: The summer staff model will include one (1) shift personnel, one (1) seasonal staff member, and weekend personnel. Grants may be available to help with additional summer staffing. Chief Bucich will report more on this at the June meeting.

District staff and volunteers continue to train with Carmen Johnson, B Shift, and Austin Loshbaugh, firefighter, to get them signed off as drivers, etc.

Water Rescues: The District has responded to three (3) water rescues so far in May.

Boosters Meeting: The McKenzie Fire & Rescue Booster Association met on Tuesday, May 10th. Discussion during the meeting included the mission and needs of the Boosters. A follow up meeting has been scheduled in September. Any decisions have been tabled until that time.

ISO Rating: The District is preparing for the ISO testing at the end of June. We could be penalized because there are minimal hydrant systems in specific areas and not throughout the District. Deputy Chief Bart Thompson overviewed the rating and point system with the Board.
